Rules: Adult & Youth Categories

- 1) All entries with the **EXCEPTION** of Fresh Baked Culinary, must be entered on **Mon. 9/27 from 8-5, Tues. 9/28 8-12** at the Lauderdale Co. Extension Office, 200 Crain St., Ripley or at the Halls Airbase Fair Grounds **Wed. 9/29 9-4. Baked goods must be there by 10:00 a.m. on Thurs. 9/30 to be judged.**
- 2) Products must be made by the person making the entry & one entry per checked box.
- 3) Entry should not be more than 5 years old except for culinary which should be fresh and displayed in disposable containers.
- 4) All contests are open to Amateurs only. An Amateur is one who does not receive compensation for their hobby/craft or teaching but may win premiums in contests.
- 5) Items having won a blue ribbon in the previous Lauderdale Co. Fairs are not eligible with the exception of culinary.
- 6) Please have entry sheets completed before entering.
- 7) Ribbons and prize money will be awarded to First place winners. Ribbons only will be given to Second and Third Place. Youth classes will be judged using the Danish System with premiums not to exceed \$2.00. Blue—\$2, Red—\$1...Best of Show rosette will be awarded in each age group.
- 8) Items may be picked up on Sat. 10/2 from 6-8 p.m., Sun 10/3 from 4-6 p.m. or Monday 10/4 8 till noon at the Extension Office. Items not picked up will be discarded.
No culinary items will be returned.
- 1) While precautions are made for safeguarding exhibits, it is understood that in no case is the Lauderdale Co. Fair, its directors, officers, or agents be held responsible for any loss or damage to an entry before, during or after the Fair.
