

LAUDERDALE COUNTY FAIR EXHIBITS
ENTRY FORM

(YOUNG ADULT)
13 -17 yrs. of age

1. Entries to be received at the fairgrounds **Exhibits Building on the Halls Airbase**. All entries with the **EXCEPTION** of Culinary must be entered on:
 - * **Wednesday 8/30 (Hours 1:00pm - 6:00pm)**
 - * **CULINARY ONLY: Thursday 8/31 (Hours 8:00am - 11:00am)**
2. All entries will be judged on Thursday 8/31. Items must be made / grown by the person named on the entry form. Culinary will be judged after 11:00am.
One (1) entry per checked box.
3. Entry should not be more than five (5) years old.
 - Culinary should be fresh and displayed in disposable containers.
 - Photo entries must be framed. **NO COLLAGES.**
4. All contests are open to amateurs only. An amateur is one who does not receive compensation for their hobby/craft or teaching, but may win premiums in contests.
5. Items having won a blue ribbon in the previous Lauderdale County fairs are not eligible with the **exception of culinary.**
6. Please have entry sheet completed when you come to enter.
7. Adults, Young Adults and Youth Winners:
 - First Place - Ribbons and prize money \$3.00
 - Second Place - Ribbons and prize money \$2.00
 - Third Place - Ribbons and prize money \$1.00
 - A "Best of Show" rosette will be awarded in each major category.
 - Horticulture and Crops will only receive ribbons.
8. Items must be picked up on Sunday 9/3/17 from 2:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m or Tuesday 9/5/17 from 10:00 a.m.- 12:00 p.m. Items not picked up will be discarded. Culinary should be picked up after 4pm on Thursday 8/31/17.
9. While precautions are made for safeguarding exhibits, it is understood that in no case will the Lauderdale County fair, its directors, officers, or agents will be held responsible for any loss or damage to an entry before, during or after the fair.
